Celebrating the 91th birthday of Emma Jackson, Covenant Partner of New Life At Calvary.

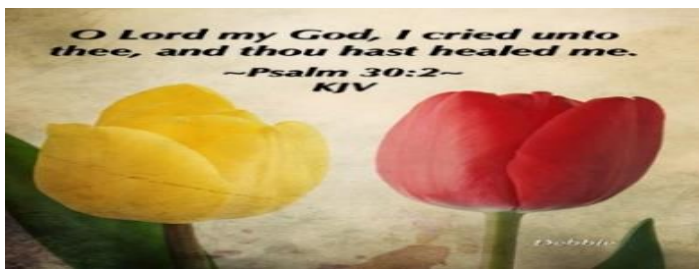
Emma Jackson will be 91 years old on February 5, 2025. She is very happy to make it to be this age. Emma Jackson grew up in Summerville, GA, on a farm. She grew up with both of her parents, 2 sisters and 8 brothers. She is the youngest of all of them, making her child number 11. They are all deceased now. As a girl she worked on the farm planting and gathering fruit, vegetables and cotton. In High School, Emma played on a basketball team in Lyerly, GA. She also ran track and did the high jump. Her father was a farmer and mom had a garden with cabbage, strawberries, black-eyed peas, peaches pears, peanuts, popcorn and much more. Her mom canned a lot of items in the Summer.

Emma went to Fort Valley State in Georgia and studied Home Economics. She was married to Dock (Glynn) Jackson after two years of college. Emma moved to Detroit with Glynn and they lived there 15 years. The couple then moved to Cleveland for work in the Fall of 1969. Emma was originally a part of the AME Zion Church and Glynn was Baptist. They couldn't agree upon churches but agreed upon being a part of the Presbyterian Church in Detroit by a friend's recommendation. His aunt recommended Calvary Presbyterian Church when they moved to Cleveland.

Emma and Glynn participated in many ministries in church including Sunday School, was President of the Women's Guild, Vacation Bible School and other Christian Ed programs. Emma Worked for the Cleveland School District as an Educational Aide and also worked with Head Start. Sometimes she made wedding cakes and likes to crotchet. She made all of her nieces an Afghan. She also enjoys crafts and sewing. Emma and Glynn had two children, Darryl and Denise. They have four grandchildren and a number of great-grandchildren.
